## **Situation Statement**

High pressure in the Tasman Sea drifts east this week then a new high forms in the Tasman Sea over the weekend. A west to southwest flow dominates for most of the time. A low forms in the tropics near Fiji but the high keeps this low well away. Pressure does weaken around the 29th and this allows a shallow low to form and bring some rain to the North Island. High pressure builds again after that with a milder northwest flow. Overeall, rainfall is below average across the country, mean temperatures are above aver age and sunshine hours are near or above average.
